### 12. Mariposa Garnacha Tempranillo, Galicia, Spain **VE**

Dry and fresh with a touch of cherry on the palate.

## White Wine

### 1. Mariposa Airen Verdejo, Galicia, Spain **VE**

Light straw with a green hint in colour and a palate that is light, dry and soft - very easy drinking.

### 2. Les Anges Sauvignon, Pichon, France **VE**

Great Sauvignon with the dryness and bite of the northern French climate. Slightly lighter than new world versions. All grapes are also sourced from 100% Loire Valley vineyards.

### 3. Il Caggio Pinot Grigio, Veneto, Italy **VE**

This delicately refreshing off dry white is lemon yellow in colour. On the palate flavours of fresh green apple and citrus are balanced well by aromas of stone fruit.

### 4. Mavida Chardonnay, Central Valley, Chile **VE**

### 5. Torrent Bay Sauvignon, Nelson, New Zealand

### 7. Mariposa Garnacha Tempranillo, Galicia, Spain **VE**

Bright red with violet hues. Aromas of redcurrant, raspberries and blackberry with a hint of spice.

### 8. Mavida Merlot, Central Valley, Chile **VE**

Unlike many of the mass market Chilean wines seen about, this wine, as with all the Mavida wines is bottled at source. Soft, easy to drink Merlot as it should be.

### 9. The War Horse Shiraz, Stellenbosch, South Africa **VE**

Typical hints of pepper and spice on the nose and a jammy flavour on the palate from the family run Simonsig estate. Named the War Horse because after the Boer War the horses came back to settle in Stellenbosch,

### 10. Castan Malbec, Southern France **VE**
